Like Jacob in Genesis 32, you will also have an experience of **wrestling with God** so that you discover your wounds as a man and experience His healing grace at a core level of your heart and soul. We live in a fallen, broken world and all of us as men have been wounded. Our wounds, if not healed cause massive damage to our souls and those around us. God's grace is the medicine that heals our wounds and frees us to be the men He wants us to be. God breaks us in order to heal and bless us. You, like Jacob, will have an ordeal – an opportunity to wrestle with God and get a new name, a new identity.

3. Finally, this weekend will help you **recover your masculine soul**. It's a good thing to be a man. God meant for men to live with purpose, passion and power. Jesus is looking to make you into a man who lives in truth and integrity with others. A man who is fully alive and engaged in life. A man who knows he has what it takes, who courageously faces his fears and helps build God's Kingdom of blessing. Do you want to be this kind of man? Are you ready to live up to your full God-given potential? The world is waiting. The time is NOW!
